

Bush Medicine Wall Hanging



Measures 30" x 34" (76cm x 86cm)

Finished block size 4" x 4"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowance

Sew with right sides together.

This versatile pattern can be made up to any size quilt you would like.

As a guide the following measurements will assist in the cutting of the blocks

From 44" wide fabric one 5" strip cut across the width will give you 8 x 5" squares

You will need 21 x 5" squares of 2 contrasting fabrics and 42 x 5" squares of background fabric.



Method of construction of half square triangle blocks

Place a 5" square of your feature fabric on top of a 5" background square.

Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of one of the squares.

Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.



Trim the corners as shown.



Cut through the square on the drawn line to make 2 half square triangle blocks.

Repeat to make 21 half square triangle blocks from each combination = 42 blocks

Wall Hanging Assembly.

Refer to the photo for block placement.

Lay out blocks with 1" (cut 1.5") sashing as shown (or as desired)

The featured wall hanging has a 2" (finished) border, and is bound in the same background fabric.

Finish by layering the top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired and bind.

(The quilt shown has been quilted in a close stipple pattern on all background fabric).
