# HARMONY QUILT

**FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 6" x 6"; FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 60" x 60"**

## **REQUIREMENTS**

**Ruler:** 1 x M&S Textiles Fabric Ruler

**Cutting Mat:** 1 x M&S Textiles Fabric Cutting Mat

**Scissors:** 1 pair x High Quality Fabric Scissors;  
1 pair x High Quality Paper Scissors;

## **M&S Textiles Australia Fabrics**

Quilt Binding & Backing - 2.4 yards Bush Banana Wide (58"/59" wide fabric)

Block Borders - Inner Border: 0.6 yards Eucalyptus Olive Green;  
Outer Border: 0.6 yards Wax Flower Blue;

0.25 yards each of the following fabrics:

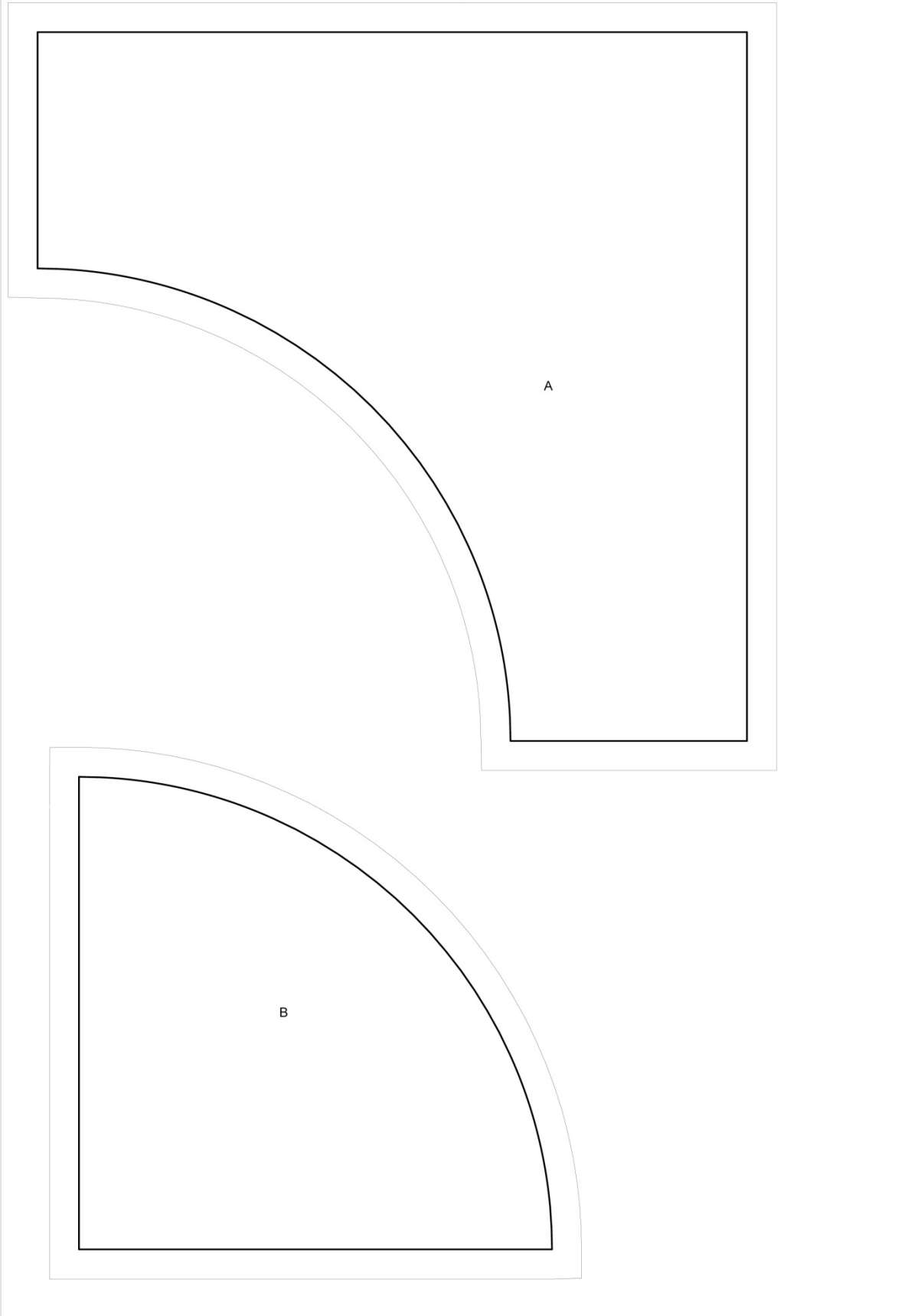
Kokos String Burgundy, Gathering Bush Food Green-Tan, Seven Sisters Red, Sandhill Charcoal, Dancing Spirit Red, Kangaroo Natural, Bush Tucker Purple, My Country Utopia Black, Wax Flower Mauve, Canteen Creek Red, Untitled Blue, Kangaroo Paw Natural, Bush Yam X2 Purple, Dancing Flowers Green, Waterhole Blue, Bush Tucker White, Landscape Green, Goanna & Snake Ecru.

**Batting:** M&S Quilter's Wonder 80/20 Cotton Poly Fusible - 2 yards

**Thread:** Any normal quilting thread

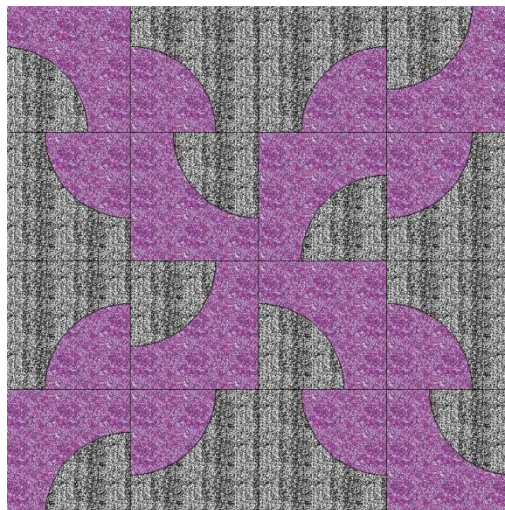
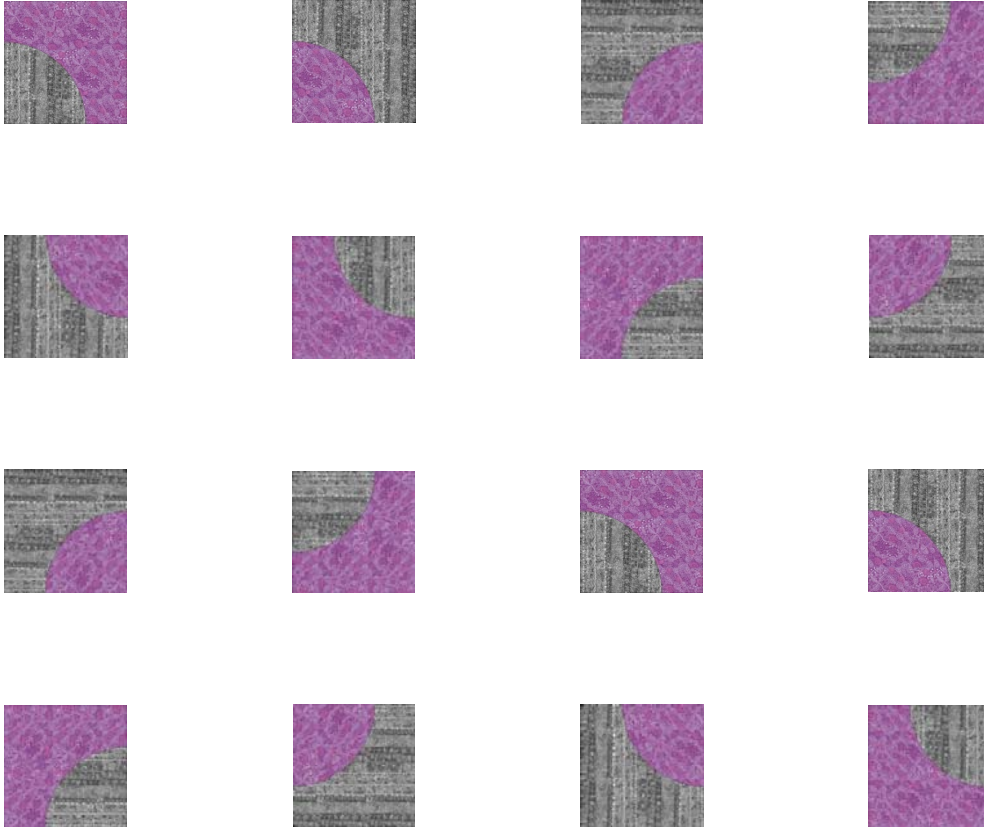
## **Step 1: Creating Blocks**

## Organizing The Blocks

- Below are 16 individual blocks of fabrics that are put at different angles.
- Join these 16 blocks to make one larger block as shown below.



- Finished size of each block will be 6" x 6" with 0.25" seam allowance.
- There will be 180 such blocks in the entire quilt.
- Cut the templates using good quality paper scissors.
- Place one paper template at a time on the right side of the fabric and use pen, white pencil or chalk to draw around the edges onto the fabric.
- Cut the fabric along these lines and you will have fabric shapes identical to the templates.
- Create block by joining 2 pieces of fabric together. Iron each block individually.
- Join these blocks in groups of 4 x 4 (that is group of 16 blocks). Create 9 such large blocks and iron each of them.
- Use machine quilting for the entire stitching process. Stitch all the 144 blocks (16 x 9) together. The quilt top is now ready. Properly iron the quilt top. Then stitch the borders around these blocks.

## **Step 2: CUTTING fabric for borders and bindings**

### **From Eucalyptus Olive Green fabric:**

Cut 4" stripes along the width of the fabric. Join the fabric together to form inner border of the quilt.

### **From Wax Flower Blue fabric:**

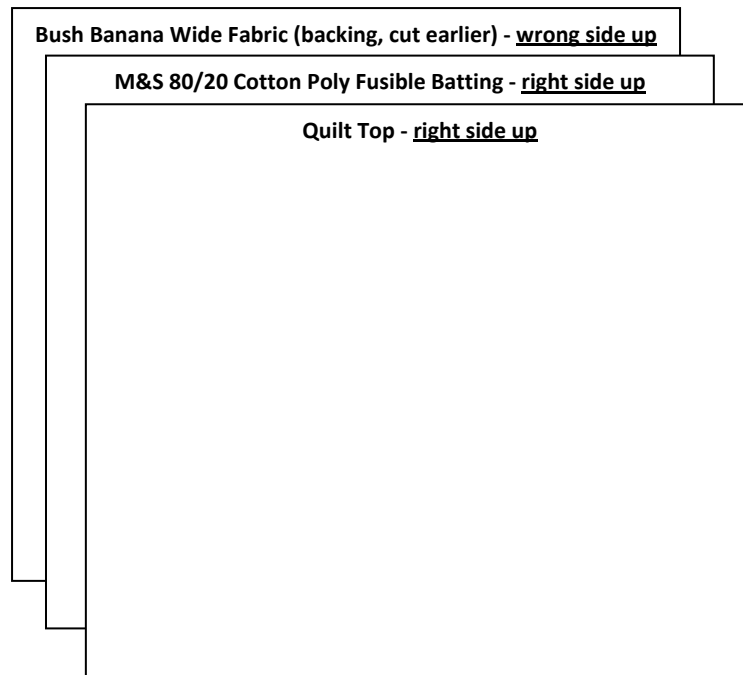
Cut 2" stripes along the width of the fabric. Join the fabric together to form outer border of the quilt.

### **From Bush Banana Wide fabric:**

Cut four 2" x 60" strips for the quilt binding.

- First, stitch the Eucalyptus Olive Green fabric across the quilt to form inner border.
- Properly iron the quilt.
- Then, stitch the Wax Flower Blue fabric to form the outer border of the quilt.
- Again iron the entire quilt.

### **Step 3: ASSEMBLING the quilt sandwich**



- Above figure shows order of assembly for backing, batting and the quilt top.
- Working on a table, assemble the layers as shown in above figure smoothing away all creases as you go. Pin the 3 layers together.
- If necessary, trim the fabric and/or batting to make the edges of the quilt even.

### **Step 4: Quilting**

- Very little quilting is required. Quilt the corners of the blocks as seen in the image of the quilt, or as you wish.

### **Step 5: APPLYING the binding**

- Take the four strips of 2" x 60" Bush Banana Wide fabric cut earlier and place around the quilt top right sides together keeping the edges even.
- Machine stitch through all layers 1/4" from the edge of the quilt top.
- Trim any excess fabric, fold the binding evenly to the back of the quilt and secure with hem stitch.
